Order of the Tribunal Date and Remarks Order No. 3 In terms of our directions contained in the order dated 28.11.2016 a 6th December, reply has been submitted by the Respondent No. 1 today. It has been 2016 submitted that drinking water supply through tankers has been commenced to three villages namely Chhinditola, Suji and Bhorkheda by six tanks every day. However, so far as villages Bhimjori and Khurshipur are concerned that is yet to be commenced. We are of the view that in the light of the joint inspection report submitted in after joint inspection by the MoEF, CPCB and MPPCB with regard to the water sample analysis as mentioned on pages 6 to 9 of the said report the Respondent No. 1 needs to immediately commence water supply through tankers to the remaining villages also as the report of the joint inspection clearly suggests that the water quality in all these villages is far from satisfactory and contains several heavy metals and other pollutants
