	Item No. 01 to 03 January 27, 2016 ss	<p>The parties have not taken any step in furtherance to our order dated 04th January, 2016. At the request of the Learned Counsel appearing for various parties we grant last opportunity to the parties to file their respective submissions within two weeks from today. In the event submissions are not filed, their rights to file such submissions shall be forfeited.</p> <p>We make it clear that the submissions should relate to all aspects of industrial & domestic sewage and all other pollutants entering directly or indirectly into the river Ganga in Segment-B of Phase-I. We particularly direct Central Pollution Control Board, Ministry of Environment & Forest & CC and Ministry of Water Resources to take a clear stand in relation to all the aspects that have been deliberated upon in the Chamber meeting where all officers of the highest rank were present. Learned Counsel appearing for Nigam submits that he would file the data and submissions within one week from today. Liberty granted.</p> <p>We direct Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board</p>

	<p>and the Learned Counsel appearing for some of the industries that Notice should be given within three days from today by public advertisement and other ways informing them of the next date of hearing, as well as stating that the matter in relation to all aspects including the industrial clusters which are the most serious source of pollution of river Ganga also could be directed to be shifted. The Board as well as the State of Uttar Pradesh shall be equally responsible for compliance of these directions.</p> <p>List these matters on 17th February, 2016.</p> <p>The Ganga meeting of Phase-2 be fixed on 04th February, 2016 at 03:00 PM in the Chamber of NGT where the Chief Secretary, concerned officers from the Nigam and all other Authorities should be present for final deliberation prior to passing of the Judgment by the Tribunal.
