

declared critical/ dark zone area, whether it is necessary for the Central Ground Water Authority to review the permission or requirements of the permissions of the Central Ground Water Authority for utilization of ground water for the existing plant also as it is not disputed that at the time of establishment of the original plant in 1999 there was no such requirement. However, when data available post the report of 2009 has earmarked the site a dark zone and declared it critical what measure does the CGWA wants to suggest for conservation and replenishment of the water resource and how it has the means to regulate the utilization of water or review the existing utilization of the ground water if no permission is necessary .

Let this matter be listed on 16th June, 2014.
