Item No. 23 July 18, 2017 sn	<p>The Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board had gone up to Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by filing an Appeal against the imposition of Rs. 5 lakhs as environmental compensation, which order has been stayed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for Review Applicant submits that he only presses the alternative prayer in the present application. We have heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the parties and direct as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The prayer for review of the direction is not pressed, thus, dismissed as such.2. The sum of Rs. 10 lakhs that the Cantonment Board is directed to pay to Central Pollution Control Board shall be paid to CPCB, however, the Cantonment Board will submit its proposal along with its payment, the manner in which they wish to develop the dumping site maintained by it.
