Copy of the affidavit be served on the Applicant as well as Respondent No.1. Copy of the affidavit filed by Respondent No1, be served on MPCB.</p> <p>None has appeared to represent the authorities of Respondent No.1, though Advocate for the Respondent No.1, Mr. Subhashchandra Pawar, is present. However, he is unable to inform the Tribunal about steps taken by Sangli, Miraj and Kupwad Municipal Corporation (SMKMC), of segregation of bio-degradable Municipal waste and MSW plant or other arrangements.</p> <p>The Health Officer, who is in-charge of operation of MSW management, as per MSW Rules, 2000, is required to give information to the Tribunal about observance of the Rules and maintenance of the plant in question.
