Order No.4 6th November, 2015	<p>The State as well as the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India and Ministry of Petroleum & Explosive Safety have submitted their reply. The commitment has been made that all efforts have been made to comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court as also the directions issued by the National Green Tribunal in its order dated 14.10.2015 with regard to the preventive action against the bursting of crackers and measuring of sound decibel levels and prevention of noise and air pollution.</p> <p>The District Administration, Sagar has filed their response about the steps taken by them so far. School, BHEL, Bhopal depicting the pictures for creating awareness which is a commendable and appreciable effort on the part of the Counsel.</p> <p>From the reply filed by the Union of India, it has been submitted that no permission or licence has been given for import of crackers from China and directions have been issued by the Government of India for all</p>

State Governments for seizure and impounding of such crackers.

The Registrar, CZB, NGT is directed to send copy of this order along with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.10.2015 to the Chief Secretaries of Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh for necessary compliance and the compliance be reported before this Tribunal on 23.11.2015 of all steps taken by each of the Respondents and State Governments for compliance of the order issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
