The answering respondent most respectfully submits as under;

- That the aforementioned case is pending adjudication before the Hon'ble Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi.
- 2. That the case was listed for hearing on 21.08.2024 wherein the Hon'ble Tribunal passed directions, operative part of which is being reproduced as under:
 - "....Para 4. DC, Doda present virtually has submitted that now needful will be done and time-bound action plan will be filed and for this purpose extension of time has been sought. Though, Tribunal had once extended time but having regard to the assurance given by DC, Doda, time for filing the time-bond action plan to remediate the situation is extended for a further period of eight weeks.

Para 5. Member Secretary, J&KPCC has filed the report dated
16.08.2024 disclosing that Environmental Compensation(EC)
of Rs. 11.55 lacs has been levied upon Executive Officer,
Municipal Committee Bhaderwah vide order dated
14.08.2024. The requisite steps are required to be taken to
recover the said EC. Hence, a further report be filed by Member



Secretary, J&KPCC in respect of recovery of EC, inter-alia reflecting the improvement/action taken, if any, to remediate the problem..."

- That in compliance to the aforementioned directions, detailed affidavit containing a time bound action plan was filed by the answering respondent on 29.11.2024.
- 4. That the case was subsequently listed for hearing on 02.12.2024 wherein the aforementioned affidavit was taken on record by the Hon'ble Tribunal. Further, the Hon'ble Tribunal passed directions to the respondents, operative part of which is being reproduced as under: -
 - "Para4: Further progress reports regarding further action taken in compliance of the action plan specifically with reference to remedial measures required to be taken for protection and improvement of environment may be filed at least one week before the date of hearing fixed.
 - 5. That in compliance to the aforementioned directions, the answering respondent has personally taken up the matter with all concerned departments viz Housing & urban Development, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Health & Medical Education and Public Works Department etc. for speedy execution of the works identified as per Action Plan.
 - 6. That a strong monitoring mechanism has been established to review the status of activities on the ground. In this context, quarterly review is being carried out by Additional Deputy Commissioner, Bhaderwah (Nodal Officer) and subsequently review meetings are being held by the answering respondent for assessing pace of the activities and passing necessary directions to the concerned. A copy of the status of action plan as on 20.03.2025 is enclosed and marked as Annexure-R1 for perusal of the Hon'ble Tribunal.

- 7. That in addition to aforementioned works, quality of water is being monitored closely alongside J&KPCC. In this context, water samples are being tested on periodic basis and it is pertinent to mention that all the samples (except sample of Puneja Nallah, wherein BOD value has been found 3.3 against 3 along with slight pungent smell) have been found conforming to the specifications. The reason for the same has been attributed largely to unavailability of Bio-Effluent treatment plant (ETP) at slaughter house and as such BOD value will get improved once ETP is installed at slaughter house. Copy of the water samples collected on 07-03-2025 and tested by J&KPCC on 13-03-2025 is enclosed and marked as Annexure-R2 for perusal of the Hon'ble Tribunal.
- 8. That further entire District administration along with all concerned departments are aligned for execution of works identified for remediation of the issue arisen and it is submitted that with the winter season nearing completion, pace of the activities will further speed up.

IN THE PREMISES,

Therefore, keeping in view of the above stated facts, it is respectfully prayed that the submissions made herein above and those to be urged at the time of hearing, the status report may kindly be considered and taken on record in the interest of justice.
