ORDER

1. In this original application, the applicant being a resident of Village Neelwal, Tikri Kalan, Delhi has raised a grievance against the illegal dumping and burning of plastic waste in violation of the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016. The applicant has also raised a grievance in respect of non-compliance of various provisions of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant referring to the facts disclosed in the submissions filed on 17.12.2024 has submitted that illegal burning and dumping of plastic and electronic waste is taking place at the following locations:-

(a) Nerula Raod, Ranohola Extension, New Delhi – 110041

(b) Jharoda Kalan, New Delhi – 110072

(c) Bakkarwala Road, Mundka, New Delhi – 110041

(d) Tikri Kalan, New Delhi

3. Learned counsel for the applicant has also referred to the photographs filed as Annexure A1/2 page 46 onwards and has submitted that the illegal burning of plastic and e-waste is causing enormous air pollution. She has also referred to the complaints filed as Annexure A1/7 page 150 and has submitted that despite various complaints to the different authorities, no action has been taken till now. She has also submitted that earlier also the applicant had filed the OA and the order was passed but there is no improvement at the ground level.

4. Issue notice to the respondents. Applicant is directed to serve the respondents and file the affidavit of service at least one week before the next hearing date. Respondents are directed to file their response/reply by way of affidavit at least one week before the next date of hearing through e-filing. If any respondent directly files the reply/affidavit without routing it through his advocate then the said respondent will remain virtually present to assist the Tribunal.
