	School which is affiliated to CBSE and there are other schools in the
	vicinity of this area. The photographs filed along with the application
	show that the Respondents authority are putting up certain structures
	for the purpose of dumping the waste materials and it is clear that the

same is just near the schools and other areas where people are occupying and we see reasons in the contention of the Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant that it is likely to cause health hazard to the students.

Accordingly, we are of the view that balance of convenience in passing some interim order is in the interest of the public especially the health of the children who come in a large number everyday and are more susceptible to contracting diseases. Accordingly, we direct the Respondents to maintain *status quo* as it exists today making it clear that no further construction shall be proceeded with till the next date of hearing.

Issue Notice to the Respondents by registered post/acknowledgement due as well as dasti. Private Notice also allowed. Notice returnable on 9th October, 2013.

In the meantime, the Municipal Commissioners of East Delhi Municipal Corporation, South Delhi Municipal Corporation, North Delhi Municipal Corporation and NDMC shall file a report regarding the scheme of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) management for their areas of the city of Delhi.
