<b>Item No. 09</b> <b>December 22, 2017</b>	<p>The present application has been moved against certain hotels/respondent nos. 1 to 6 for seeking relief of restoration of environment and protection of ground water level.</p> <p>Parties before us particularly the hotels submit that all the respondents have duly given replies to the main application and dispute awaits the decision.</p> <p>It is stated on behalf of the hotels that all the hotels hold permissions for extraction of ground water granted by the concerned competent authorities as per the extant guidelines and reports of the joint inspections are also on record.</p> <p>Issue of revised fresh guidelines, it is submitted on behalf of the hotels, only arise as regards the fresh permission to be granted for extraction of ground water in the said area.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Govt. of</p>
