Counsel undertakes to appear on behalf of the Jharkhand State Pollution Control He undertakes to file vakalatnama, status report and Board. action taken report on behalf of State PCB on the issue.

regard to the respective affidavits and Having considering the rampant illegal sand mining in the State of Jharkhand there will be an order of injunction restraining operation of sand mining of any nature in respect of any unit in the State of Jharkhand without valid consent to operate from State Board and without environmental clearance. The Chief Secretary, Govt. of Jharkhand is directed to take steps and measures to implement this order in the State. The District Magistrate and the Superintendent of Police of Godda District are directed to take steps and measures to implement the interim order as passed today and shall ensure that no sand mining is allowed without EC by SEEIA & consent to operate from Pollution Control Board. Registry is directed to communicate this order to the Chief Secretary of the State, DM, Godda District, Jharkhand and the S.P. Godda District forthwith.
