	Item No. 08 March 02, 2016	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>M.A. Nos. 35/2016 and 36/2016</u></p> <p>We have heard the Learned counsel appearing for the parties. The joint inspection team report has been filed and taken on record. In terms of the report the Unit appears to have taken all anti pollution measures. However, there is one of the minor deficiencies which remains to be addressed, Learned counsel appearing for the industry submit that they would take all measures completely and immediately and would obtain permission of the CGWA.</p> <p>In the circumstances afore-noticed and the joint inspection report dated 29th February, 2016 we permit the industry to operate for a period of two months from Monday that is 07th March, 2016 within which period the industry would operate to its optimum capacity subject to the joint inspection by CPCB, UP Pollution Control Board,</p>

representative of IIT Roorkee and MoEF. There shall be complete and comprehensive inspection report in terms of the previous orders of the Tribunal as passed in other cases. The trade effluent shall be analysed and the analyses reports placed before the Tribunal. If the report submitted before the Tribunal is favourable to the industry and it is found compliant and non-polluting the consent order will be issued but same would become operative subject to the orders of the Tribunal. In the event of default the Unit shall be closed forthwith.

The complete report with regard to water consumption should also be submitted.

Once the report is submitted to the Registry the same shall be registered in accordance with rules and place the same before the Tribunal for directions. We make it clear that that report should positively be filed within two months as directed above.

Accordingly, M.A. Nos. 35/2016 and 36/2016 stands disposed of without any order as to costs.
