	Item No. 8 September 28, 2015	<p>Heard. Perused.</p> <p>This application was initiated upon a letter dated 30.07.2015 alleging running of the industries, namely, P.R. Industries, M/s. Mahadev Craft & Boards Pvt. Ltd. and M/s. Ganesh Polymers Ltd. more correctly M/s. G.P.L. Polyfills Ltd. in violation of the environmental norms and connivance of the enforcing agency – UPPCB with their activities.</p> <p>Before issuing notice to these industries, we had directed joint inspection of the said industries to be conducted by the Sr. Officers of the CPCB and UPPCB. Inspection reports dated 26.8.2015 and 28.9.2015 are now before us. We find from the inspection reports that M/s. P.R. Industries and M/s. Mahadev Crafts & Boards Pvt. Ltd. are the units not in operation. However, the reports also point out that these units suffer from certain shortcomings and as such units should not be allowed to operate till compliance is made and the shortcomings removed. Despite this, learned Counsel appearing for the applicant submits that M/s. P.R. Industries is being run clandestinely during night</p>

time and the pollution continues unabated.

As regards the operation of M/s. G.P.L. Polyfills, the inspection report also reveals some shortcomings and requires the unit to comply with the discharge standards and to take certain measures for improving the performance of anti pollution devices. We have also before us the resume of the grievances in a format as required under the National Green Tribunal Act i.e. in the application format. The Applicant is granted liberty to carry out necessary amendments in the said application in light of what is revealed before us. Amendments shall be carried out within a week. Amended copies shall be furnished to the CPCB and UPPCB.

List this matter on 7th October, 2015 for further consideration.
