Item No. 04 10th March, 2016	<p>M.A. No. 162/2016 filed by Shri Ayush Dev Bajpai, Learned Counsel for M/s C.J. Gelatine seeking urgent hearing of this matter is allowed and disposed of.</p> <p>Dr. P.S. Bundela, Regional Officer, MPPCB, Bhopal informs us that M/s C.J. Gelatine has installed the RO (reverse osmosis) plant of the installed capacity. However, it is his submission that some more things are required to be done by the company, namely : (1) installation of distilled water meter (2) the <i>kachha</i> lagoon existing now to be converted to <i>pucca</i> ones (3) installation of bag filter in the boiler house (4) installation of web based camera and (5) installation of multi effect evaporator.</p> <p>Shri Ayush Dev Bajpai, Learned Counsel for the company on instructions, submits that there is no necessity of installation of multi effect evaporator. This is a matter which the company can sort out by mutual discussion with the R.O., MPPCB who is an expert on the subject.</p> <p>In the meanwhile, considering the further requirements to be put in place as indicated by the R.O., MPPCB, we are inclined to permit M/s C.J. Gelatine to operate the plant subject to the fulfilment</p>

of the conditions set out by the R.O., MPPCB and against Bank Guarantee of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Ten Lakhs) as security.

It is made clear that the process of installation of the remaining requirements shall be completed within a period of six months. It is also made abundantly clear that there should be no discharge of treated waste water outside the plant.

With these directions M.A. No. 165/2016 stands disposed of.

In the light of the above directions the MPMKVVCL and MPAKVN shall restore the water connection respectively to the plant of M/s C.J. Gelatine.

In view of the above, M.A. No. 133/2016 stands disposed of.
