

direct the parties to make further endeavour in this direction and submit details thereof on the next date. In the event they are unable to do so, we shall presume that no other pond exists and the matter shall be dealt with without any further delay.

We have perused the records and from the affidavits of the DL & LRO, we find that in Annexure-R1 filed by him, the details of the land records pertaining to the area in question containing the names of the recorded owners and their addresses have been given. Perhaps, there may not be further information in this regard. However, as already directed, further efforts may be made by the parties.

We make it clear that the interim order dt. 23.3.2015 passed by us restraining the Howrah Municipal Corporation, Developers, Contractors and all persons concerned from doing any work relating to filling up of the water bodies by dumping garbage and construction debris as well as discharging untreated water into the ponds, shall continue to be operative. If this order is found to have been violated in any manner we shall be compelled to take coercive measures against those who are responsible.
