We have been informed that as many as about 10 lakh pilgrims visit the temple during the *Navratras*. The management of the Trust in consultation with the district administration and taking the advice of the experts are to draw up a programme to ensure firstly that no new construction is allowed to be carried out on the fragile eco-system of the hill of the *Maa Sharda* temple at Maiher and any temporary arrangements that may be made shall keep in view of the fact the issue with regard to the number of the persons of the devotees that can be accommodated at a given time on the hill itself and a system of sending the devotees in batches to ensure that too many people are do not crowd on the hill itself. The time slot may also be kept in mind. Any activity which may be detrimental to the environment or which may occasion landslide etc. such as use of amplifiers and loudspeakers at very high decibel also need to be regulated.

The views of the experts on all these issues shall be taken into account by the District Collector and steps taken accordingly. The report shall also indicate the nature of vegetation and tress etc. which have been planted on the hill while carrying out the restoration work. If not already taken note of. The planting of bamboo shoots and other species capable of binding and retaining the soil may be considered and carried out. This report with regard to regulating the flow of devotees and the steps taken in this behalf shall be reported to this Tribunal by 24.09.2015.

Let the matter be listed on 28th September, 2015.
