On $27^{\text {th }}$ May, 2014 we had directed that the Respondents shall stop any construction activity reported to be going on either in the river bed or the flood plain area or 30/33 Mtr green belt area. We had also directed the Respondent No.4/Director, Town \& Country Planning, M.P. to submit a report on inspection of the premises as to whether any construction has been carried out in the $30 / 33 \mathrm{Mts}$. wide green-belt area required to be maintained along the river Kaliasot. However, there was no fruitful response from the Director, Town \& Country Planning to the said direction as on $11^{\text {th }}$ July, 2014.
