	Item No.02 January 11, 2016	<p>Heard. Perused Record.</p> <p>Service is complete. The present case concerns air, water and noise pollution created by unauthorized and illegal industries run in non-conforming residential areas at Mandoli, Delhi lying within in the limits of East Delhi Municipal Corporation. It appears that the facts disclosed in the application in relation to the pollution caused by running of these industries in a manner stated are not disputed. Air, water and noise pollution is occurring as a result of burning of oil, rubber tyres, wires and scrap etc. by the units illegally run in Mandoli.</p> <p>It appears from the letter dated 10-11-2014 written by the DPCC to Deputy Commissioner, Factory Licensing Department EDMC at annexure A-7 that the DPCC requested the Municipality to take action and close of some industrial units run in the non-conforming residential area in terms of the order dated 07-05-2004 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.</p> <p>Learned Counsel appearing for the EDMC</p>

submits that they have identified 12 erring industrial units in Mandoli and directed disconnection of electricity and water supply to these industrial units. According to him, electricity is supplied by BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. and water is supplied by the DJB. According to the applicant there are more than 12 units, may be 100, which are run in violation of law at Mandoli Area and these units contribute to air, water and noise pollution massively.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the EDMC further submits on instructions that there is a public grievance committee comprising of SDM, NandNagri, DPCC, EDMC and Delhi Police to carryout survey of the entire area, identify the units and take requisite action against them as per the law.

Let SDM, Nand Nagri Sub Divison, DPCC, S.H.O. Harsh Vihar, Police Station, BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. and DJB be made party Respondents to the present application. Necessary amendments be made in the application.

Issue notice to the SDM, Nand Nagri Sub Divison, DPCC, S.H.O. Harsh Vihar, Police Station, BSES Yamuna Power Ltd. and DJB by registered post/acknowledgement due and dasti as well. Notice made returnable on 25th January, 2016.

List the matter on 25th January, 2016.
