Orders of the Tribunal Date and Remarks Item No. 6 The joint inspection team report has been placed on November 26, 2015 record. According to the report the industry is found to be Α However a direction has been issued for compliant. installation of dual media filter in the ETP for its upgradation. Learned counsel appearing for Applicant submits that they would provide the said filter, for which the order has been placed, within four days from today. She submits that they may be permitted to operate as the effluents will take atleast 10 days to reach the ETP and they have storing capacity of 18000 cubic meter in the lagoon. For the reasons afore-stated we permit the industry to operate and to start its operation of crushing. But it will not release any effluent from its lagoon into any discharge point either drain, land or water bodies. The joint inspection team shall conduct inspection after one week and would analyze the effluent being

discharged by the industry at intake of the ETP and outlet of the ETP as well as collected effluents in the lagoon and final point of discharge by the industry.

The report would be put before the Tribunal within three weeks from today. The industry is being permitted to operate provisionally and if found to be defaulting on any ground whatsoever, it shall be liable to be shut down and the Applicant will not take take any benefit as it has already been crushed the sugarcane and is likely to suffer economic loss.

With the above orders, Original Application No. 502 of 2015 stands disposed of without any order as to costs.

We make it clear that the report should be filed immediately after expiry of three weeks.

The Registry would place the report before the Tribunal for directions.
